Mission Projects 2018-2020

A mission “mite” goal of 107,000 was set by the delegates at the 2018-2020 District LWML convention.

3. District Professional Church Workers Financial Aid: \$25,000
4. Ashland Cares, Inc.-Homeless Shelter: \$12,000

6. Mission of Hope, Gwinn, Michigan: \$20,000
7. Operation Barnabas for Comfort Dog Congregations: \$2,500
8. “Wonderfully Made” – Resources for People of All Abilities-Bethesda: \$7,000
9. Derricks Family, Missionary Support in Cameroon, Africa, with Lutheran Bible Translators: \$5,500

How We Do It?

Mite boxes are used to collect monetary gifts for the selected Mission Projects.



- ❖ 25% of the mite offering is sent to National LWML for mission projects and the remaining 75% is used for our district mission goals.
- ❖ One box alone is not enough to fund scholarships or buy equipment for new missions – but one box multiplied by 200,000 other boxes from the entire league equals millions.
- ❖ Place your box wherever you see it, i.e., dressing table, office, desk, car, kitchen counter, etc. You “might” want to give a “mite” box to family and friends.
