But this was not always the case. Sadie grew up in a house filled with chaos and abuse. By the time she was a teenager, she was reckless, involved in one toxic relationship after another, and deemed no consequences existed for her actions. Home became jail or treatment centers. Now at risk of being

terminated from a fourth rehab center and finding herself pregnant with a second child (she lost her rights to the first one), she knew something had to change. She needed a positive environment to help her change her attitude towards herself and give her the opportunity to raise her son. Sadie reached out to the Hannah Center.

The Hannah Center in Marshfield, Wisconsin bases their mission on 1 John 3:17-18: But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth. This non-profit organization begins by teaching the true meaning of life through Jeus Christ. The program focuses on goal setting and provides the tools to help achieve them through support, advocacy and life skills classes.





This center is really home and seeks to help women in crisis, whether that be chronic poverty, homelessness, abuse, addiction or pregnancy. They are committed to preserving life, providing a home and promoting change.
