## **GUIDELINES FOR ADDING SPEAKERS**

Please send the following information to the North Wisconsin District Human Care Chair for any speaker that is willing to be placed on our permanent list (which means they are willing to be contacted by other zones, societies, or the District for speaking engagements):

- Speaker's name and contact information (address, phone, email)
- Name, phone, and/or email of person recommending speaker
- Title and brief summary of speaker's presentation

Be sure you get approval from one of the District Counselors for any new speaker. If this is a problem for you let the Chair know and she will contact the Counselor for you. Since you were the one who contacted the speaker it would be easier, because of first hand contact, to answer any questions the Counselor may have. Be sure to let the Counselor know if this is a one-time engagement or that the speaker agrees to be put on our permanent list.

## **HOSTING A SPEAKER**

Choose the Speaker to accomplish a definite purpose. Issue the invitation well in advance. Mention the fee to be paid in the first contact - \$35 plus 35 cents per mile for District and Zone events.

Inform the Speaker regarding:

- Date and time of meeting
- Subject matter
- Emphasis or theme of meeting
- Allotted speaking time (suggested time 45 to 60 minutes)
- Time slot of program
- If meal or dessert will be served
- Audience expected: numbers, ages, gender, or other info
- Equipment required (DVD, VCR, PA system, etc.)
- Directions and/or map to meeting place
- Name and number of contact person

Arrange beforehand:

- To get biography and photo if need for publicity
- For hostess meet Speaker at the door

- Introduce Speaker to officers, special quests, and others
- To start program on time
- To make a brief introduction of the Speaker
- To extend thanks and pay respects promptly
- To have payment ready for Speaker before departure
- To escort Speaker to the door and offer help if needed

After the meeting:

- Write a note of thanks to the Speaker
